Tutors design and deliver weekly or bi-weekly sessions in a 1:1 tutoring format. Tutors are part-time employees at Oak Learners and work collaboratively with other members of the educational team.

Main Duties:

- Provide academic support and coaching for assigned students in academic subjects and study skills, either individually or in study groups.
- Create, research and obtain curriculum and teaching tools that suit the needs of each individual student
- Maintain records on each student who is being tutored, as well as prepare and submit evaluations and other reports as requested
- Maintain regular communication with parents about their child's progress, including maintaining the "Reflection Book" and providing in-person feedback
