- High Angle
- Straight Angle
- Low Angle
- Long Shot (LS)
- Extreme Long Shot (ELS)
- Medium Shot (MS)
- Close-up (CU)
- Extreme Close-up (ECU)

Remember to stay safe while taking photos and avoid any shot that puts you or others in danger. Always ask for permission before photographing anyone.
